Where do we come from? What was our plan?



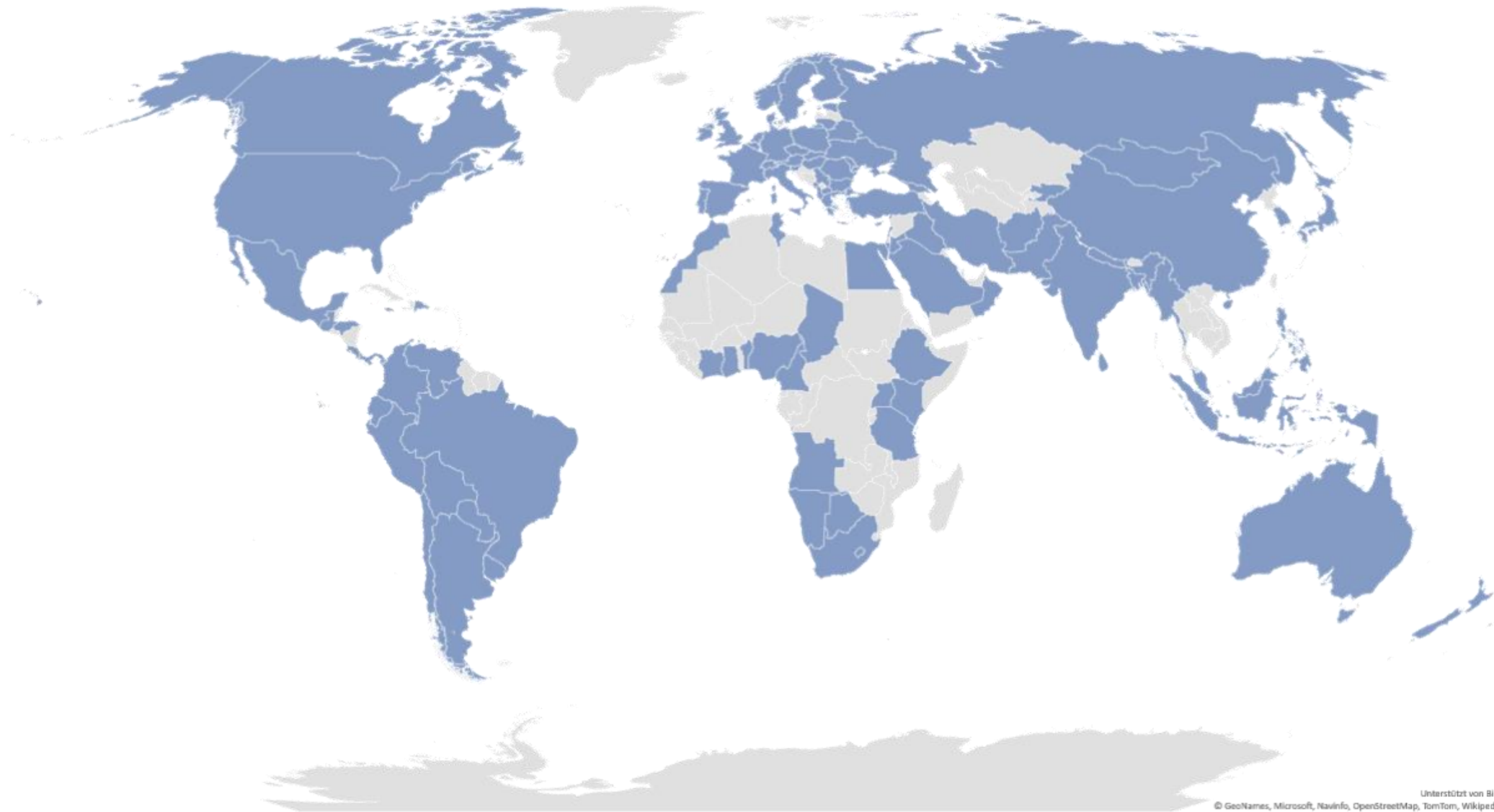

For this, the project placed a certain importance in the engagement of multiple stakeholders and aimed to establish a SD community.

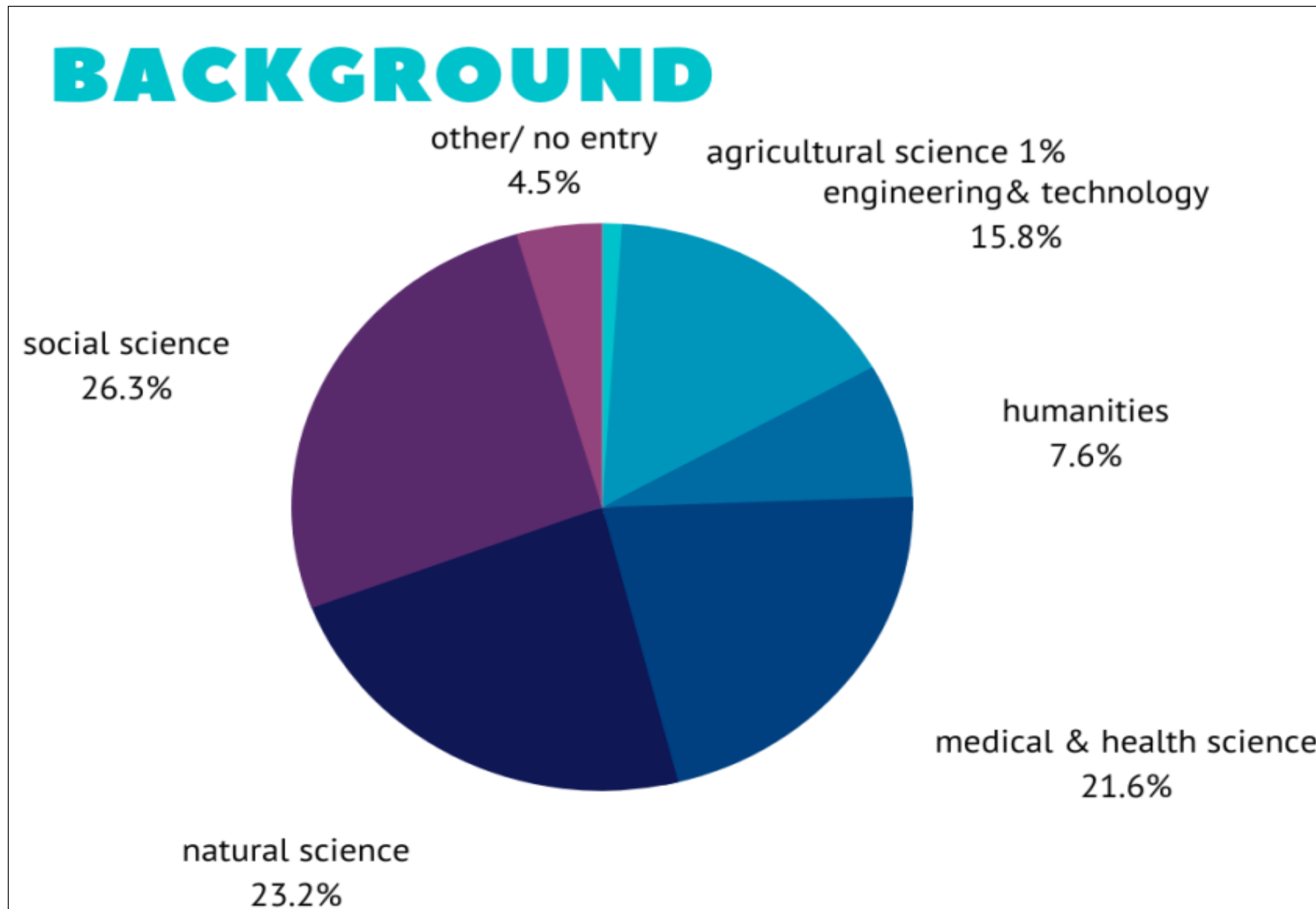

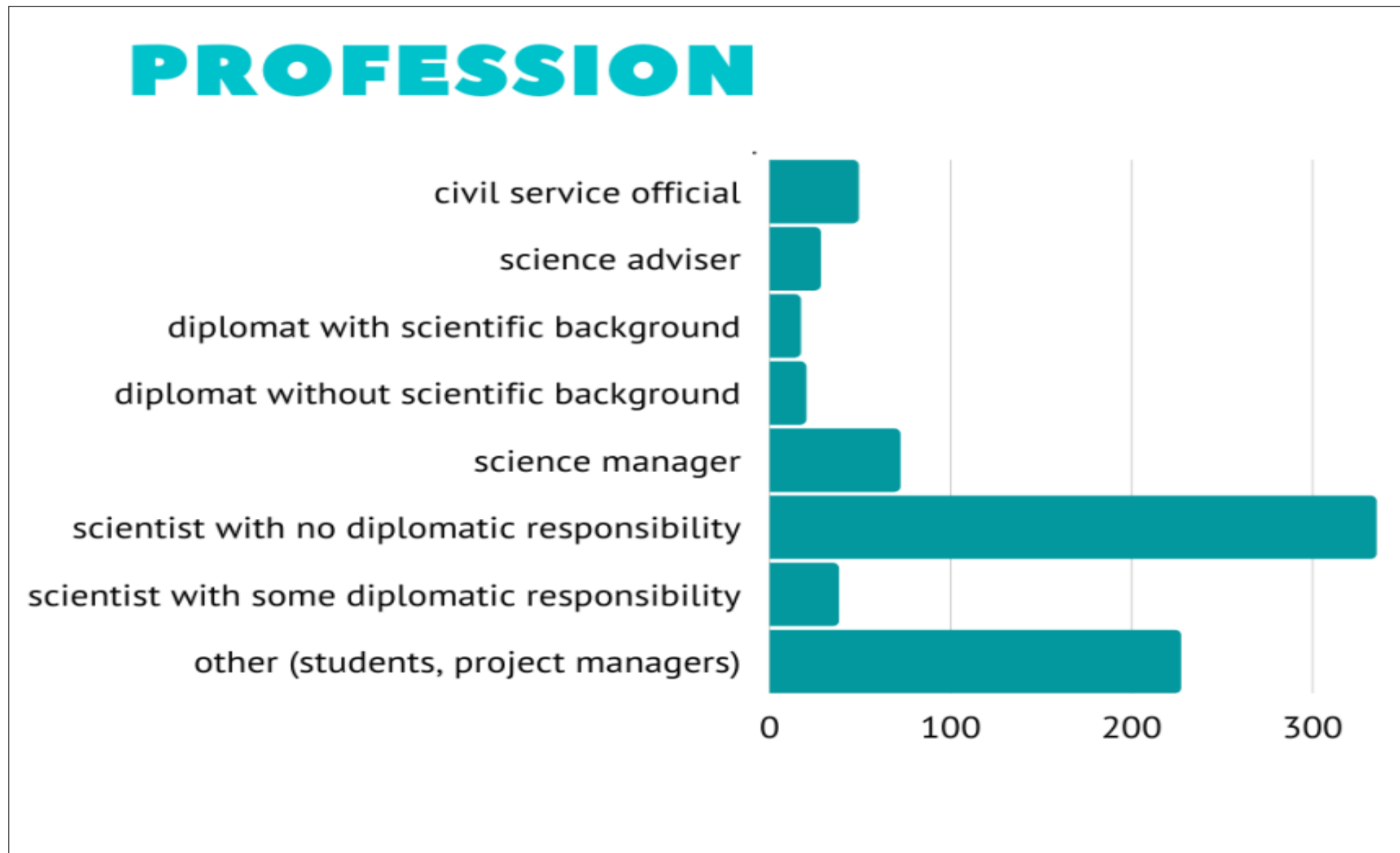


Achievement 1: Global Outreach and Connectivity
